CAMP is designed to support the research development of staff from community based organisations to facilitate the application of research principles and practices within grass roots programs. CAMP aims to link local community organisations and CHaSR to work in a mutually beneficial partnership on small, community based research projects. The 'project' can be an entire process, or small components of a larger project.

Eligibility

To be eligible to apply for CAMP, applicants should:

- Be employees of a small-medium sized not-for-profit organisation that have limited capacity or dedicated expertise to conduct or integrate research practices to the work of their organisation
- Have the support of their employer/ organisation to 'go on CAMP'
- Align with CHaSR's mission and ACU's Community Engagement principals

General Criteria

The following criteria will be taken into account when reviewing applications:

- The demonstrated gap in the organisation's knowledge and capacity and how this CAMP will help address that gap.
- The potential for knowledge translation and real life impact for the communities that the CAMPer works with
- The quality of the written application (use clear and concise language)
- The potential for ongoing or future collaborations
